

THOMAS KINKADE GALLERIES are favorites in 3 locations this year: Sonoma (on the Plaza), Calistoga (1409 Lincoln Avenue) and at our Upvalley winner, GALLERY 1870, on the first floor of Vintage 1870 in Yountville. Each displays rooms full of KINKADE, everything set against forest green walls, from collector-edition graphic prints of KINKADE'S trademark large-format "light" landscapes in your choice of frames ... to books, calendars, framed plaques, tapestries, puzzles,

and night lights.

The Napa winner, JESSEL GALLERY on Atlas Peak Road, near Silverado Country Club, is a big artistic enterprise: 10,000 square feet of original art by hundreds of artists, beautifully displayed in room after comfortable, music-filled room. Yes, there's a roomful of JESSEL'S own marvelously colorful work (Remember the Mustard Festival posters, the children's books, the painted furniture?).
